








Spending time abroad during PhD studies: an overview

- Research studies
- Teaching
- Participating in conferences and congresses
- Participating in further education programmes
- Participating in language courses, specialised courses, summer schools etc.
- Postdoc scholarships







Research studies abroad whilst studying for a PhD in Bielefeld

- Subject-related activity abroad
 - Working in a working group abroad
 - Library or archive related visits
 - Empirical studies/Field research
 - Performing experiments
- Adding value for the PhD dissertation

≻No enrolment

• Select archives





Organization

• Language skills

>mostly, no official language test is required

- Research permit
 - ≻Often required in African countries
- Usually no tuition fees for research stay at a university
- Health insurance
- Apply for visa
 - >At Ambassy/Consulate of host country in Germany

Scholarships and Funding Options

- DAAD-scholarships: <u>www.daad.de</u>
 - Short-term periods of research study of 1-6 months
 - Medium-term periods of research study of 7-12 months
 - Bi-nationally supervised PhD (Cotutelle de thèse): specific conditions apply
 - Scholarships for certain subjects and certain countries (e.g. Fulbright grant for research in the US)
 <u>Prerequisites:</u>
 - Outstanding academic qualifications
 - Studying abroad to add value to the dissertation
 - Good language skills
 - Various deadlines











DAAD Scholarship: Combination with other Funding Sources

Research Training Groups:

- Fellows: DAAD application possible
- Scholars: short-term scholarships: top-ups with DAAD

Long-term scholarships when group scholarship temporarily suspended

NRW funding loan: Top-up of PhD state funding

Scholarship Programme of organisations for the promotion of talents: no DAAD funding available

Position as a research assistant: DAAD funding available
